Houses multiple adult cats or teenage kittens at a time. 5" x 7" plaque


# Regular Dog Kennel - \$150

Carter came into our care as a very tiny, very sick kitten in October 2019. He was literally hanging on by a thread. He immediately went to a wonderful foster home where his foster mom, Judy, gave him around the clock care and lots of love. Because of her dedication, Carter survived.

As Carter grew into a healthy kitten, we noticed that he made a frequent snoring sound. Judy took him to lots of veterinary appointments and gave him various prescribed medications, but it never went away. We learned that it was Stridor and that it would be something that Carter would have to live with. Despite this, he continued to be a very playful kitten.

After a year of being in our care, and receiving so much love from Judy and other shelter volunteers, Carter found his forever family this past December.
